Introduction

The Ethics Ambassador Training Programme is a programme designed to support the ethics function/office in the organisation.

Ethics Ambassadors are individuals at any level of the organisation that help to build an ethical culture. They provide ethics advisory services to employees, help the ethics function to implement two-way communication by allowing dissemination of ethics related information throughout the organisation as well enabling insight into the dilemmas and challenges faced within the organisation.

Ethics Ambassadors are trained to provide information regarding ethics-related information to employees, facilitate ethics related issues employees may have and help employees to evaluate and resolve ethical dilemmas/challenges. They act as a vital component of the ethics management function.

Facilitation and learning

The course will be facilitated by Dr Paul Vorster and Fatima Rawat ethics subject matter experts at The Ethics Institute.

The entire programme should take learners about 5 to 6 hours in terms of learning time and includes 2 live webinar sessions with the facilitators (one at the beginning of the programme and one to conclude the programme).

Terms and conditions

1. Registrations close one week before a programme starts. All registrations not paid two weeks prior to the event will be cancelled to accommodate people from the waiting list.
2. Bookings are only confirmed on receipt of a registration form, full payment, or a Purchase Order in the case of government departments.
3. Cancellations two weeks prior incur a 30% penalty. No refunds will be made on cancellations incurred one week prior to the programme. Applicants who have made payment may be substituted by another person at any time prior to the event without incurring an additional fee. The Ethics Institute must be notified of any changes in writing.
4. Late registrations will have a 24-hour window period to confirm their registration and payment.
5. All registrations not conforming to these terms and conditions will be cancelled at no cost to The Ethics Institute.
