Workshop background?

With the growing maturity of ethics management in the public service, regulations have now been put in place to ensure that ethics management is entrenched in the governance structures of public service organisations.

The Public Service Regulations, 2016, requires the establishment or designation of ethics committees in all departments.

For most managers designated to establish or serve on these committees this is a new responsibility.

This workshop will explore the purpose and working of public service ethics committees, as well as current good practices and trends around their establishment and functionality.

What content is covered?

- Governance of Ethics
- Understanding the regulatory framework, role and mandate of public service ethics committees
- Leading practice around the establishment and functionality of public service ethics committees
