The Ethics Institute (TEI) is proud to announce the fifth **Ethics Initiative of the Year Award**. The award provides the opportunity to ethics practitioners to share successes and to learn from their peers.

This year's focus will be on

“Organisational Ethics in Times of Covid-19”.

For the first round of selections, we would like to encourage participants to send us a short description of their ethics initiatives and how they have managed ethics interventions in spite of Covid-19 using any medium of their choice. In the description, we would like participants to describe the following:



- Tell us about a specific ethics initiative in their organisation in the last 18 months.
- Did Covid-19 create the need for changes to ethics initiatives? If so, what were those changes?
- Has Covid-19 enhanced or diminished ethics awareness in the organisation?
- What lessons have been learnt from the experience?

The best submissions will be requested to provide additional information. Ultimately the top three nominations will be shortlisted by a panel of assessors comprising representatives from, TEI and the Ethics Practitioners' Association (EPA).

The final three shortlisted initiatives will be invited to present at our annual Ethics Officer Learning Forum on 18 September 2022 where delegates will have the opportunity to ask questions and vote on the worthiest initiative.
