

Ethics Champions Online Workshop

24 November, 9:00 – 13:00



Background

The active management of ethics has become common practice in both the public and private sectors. In the process, the roles of different functionaries responsible for making ethics real have become more crystallised. The role players are, among others, social and ethics committees, **ethics champions**, ethics managers and officers, line managers, and ethics ambassadors.

What is an ethics champion?

Ethics champions provide the initial impetus and ensure that organisational ethics initiatives maintain momentum. The ethics champion is formally assigned by the CEO/Accounting Officer. It could even be the CEO/Accounting Officer him/herself who fulfils this role.

This person is usually a well-respected and credible member of the executive management team. The formally nominated ethics champion plays the role of taking ownership of, and defending and advocating, the cause of ethics at the executive level of the organisation. The ethics champion also typically reports to both the executive management and the governing body on the ethics performance of the organisation.

What content is covered?

In this half-day workshop, our experts will explain and position the role of the ethics champion in organisations. The programme contents are aimed at equipping ethics champions with the skills necessary for their role and responsibilities. The following topics will be covered:



- Ethics: A shared meaning.
- The governance of ethics: A framework.
- The role of the ethics champion.
- Skills required by an ethics champion.
- Ethical leadership – how ethics champions build ethical cultures.
- Ethical decision-making.

Workshop format

- Plenary session.
- Presentations.
- Panel discussion with ethics champions.
- Audience participation through Q and A.

Who should attend?

This training is for you if you have been formally assigned as an organisation's ethics champion, or if you are member of the Ethics Committee of the governing body. You will even benefit from this course if you do not work in a formal ethics management role, but are committed to advocating and defending the ethics cause at an executive level. - CEOs/Accounting Officers.
- Senior organisational leadership.
- Ethics managers and practitioners.

Terms and conditions

1. Registrations close two weeks before a programme starts. All registrations not paid two weeks prior to the event will be cancelled to accommodate people from the waiting list.
2. Due to the 'hands-on' nature of the course, only a limited number of delegates can be accommodated.
3. Bookings are only confirmed on receipt of a registration form, full payment, or a Purchase Order in the case of government departments.
4. Candidates are required to submit a copy of their ID, as well as their highest qualification, when submitting their registration forms.
5. Cancellations two weeks prior incur a 30% penalty. No refunds will be made on cancellations incurred one week prior to the programme. Applicants who have made payment may be substituted by another person at any time prior to the event without incurring an additional fee. The Ethics Institute must be notified of any changes in writing.
6. Late registrations will have a 24-hour window period to confirm their registration and payment.
7. All registrations not conforming to these terms and conditions will be cancelled at no cost to The Ethics Institute.
