Over the past decade, South Africa has witnessed a significant decline in ethical standards within organisations. This decline has been a cause for concern, reaching a peak as revelations about corrupt practices surfaced during the Zondo Commission of Inquiry into State Capture. There is no doubt that the period of state capture had a profound negative impact on the moral fabric of organisations in the private, public, and state-owned sectors. In our history as a democracy, there has never been such a pressing need for the restoration of ethical leadership in our organisations.

Our conference theme, **Arising from the ashes – stories of ethics restoration**, is dedicated to exploring the ethical leadership journeys of individuals who have steered their respective organisations through times of crisis and emerged stronger, working diligently to restore their organisations' reputation and trust.

The conference consists of two parts: an Ethical Leadership Symposium followed by a practical ethics workshop. The event is presented in a hybrid format, offering the option to attend either in person or virtually.
