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POINTS**

When an employee speaks up, will your managers know what to do?

Nearly half of employees who report misconduct do so directly to a supervisor or manager rather than through a hotline or formal reporting channel. This makes managers a critical part of every organisation's whistleblowing framework.

A manager's first response can determine whether a concern is addressed appropriately or whether an employee decides never to speak up again.

This practical workshop equips managers with the knowledge and confidence to respond appropriately to whistleblowing disclosures, support employees, and ensure concerns are escalated through the correct channels.

Participants will explore the manager's role in creating a speak-up culture and learn how to avoid common mistakes that can undermine trust or expose the organisation to risk.
